your Friend & Servant

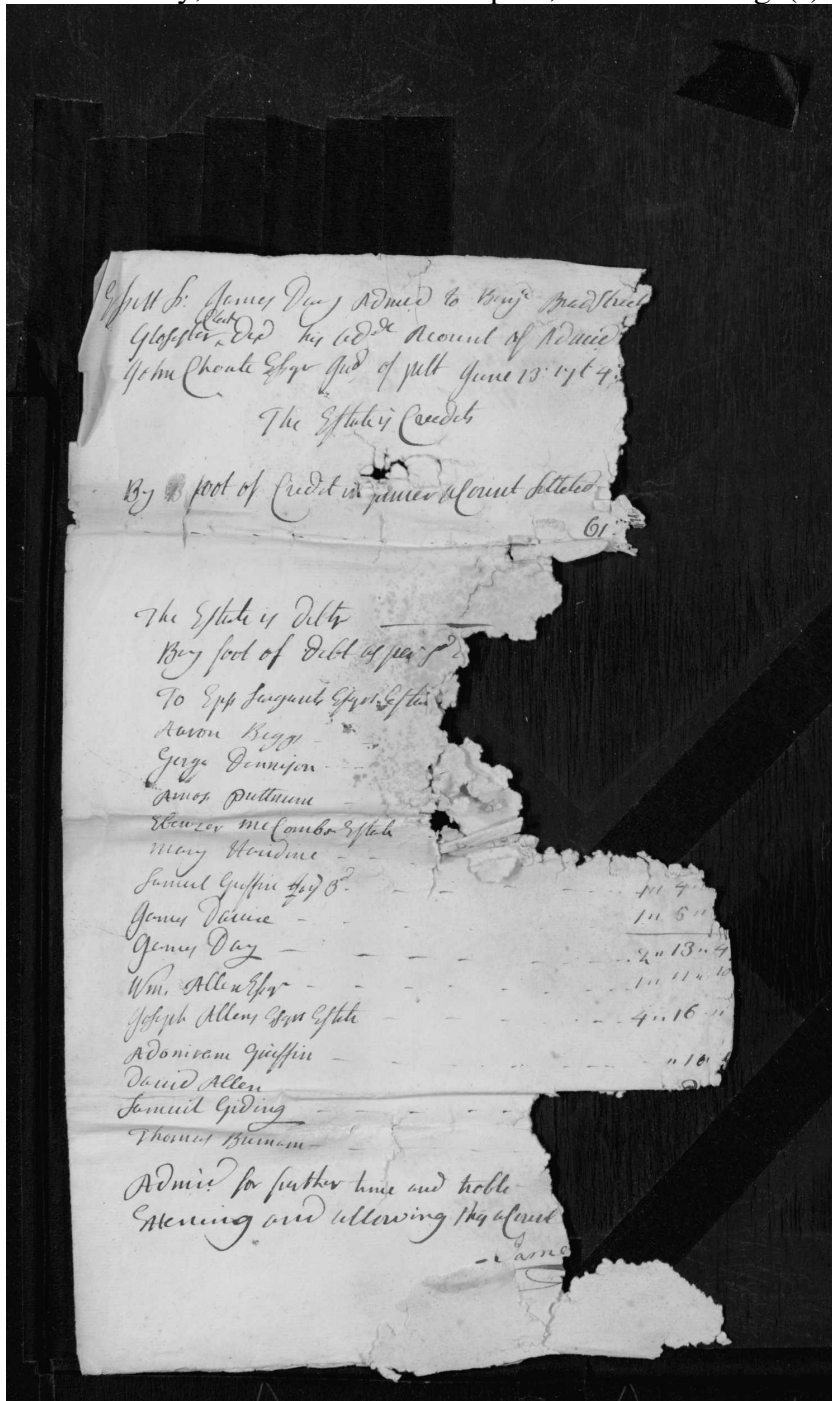
