and each of our Heirs, Executors and Administrators, jointly and severally, for
the whole and in the whole, firmly by these Presents. Sealed with our Seals.

of our Lord *One thousand seven hundred and ninety*

THE Condition of this present Obligation is such,
That if the above-bounden *Daniel Day Administrator of the*
Estate of Aaron Day late of Ipswich aforesaid Thomas
wright deceased

do make, or cause to be made, a true and perfect Inventory of all and singular the
Goods, Chattels, Rights and Credits of the said deceased, which have, or shall come
to the Hands, Possession or Knowledge of the said *Daniel Day*
or into the Hands and Possession of any other Person or Persons
for *him* and the same, so made, do exhibit, or cause to be exhibited, into the
Registry of the Court of Probate for the said County of *Essex* at
or before the *seventh* Day of *December* next ensuing;
and the same Goods, Chattels, Rights and Credits, and all other the Goods, Chattels,
Rights and Credits of the said deceased, at the Time of *his* Death, which at any
Time after shall come to the Hands and Possession of the said *Daniel Day*
or into the Hands and Possession of any other Person or Persons
for *him* do well and truly administer according to Law: And further, do make,
