

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS,

That I, Nathaniel Day of Manchester, County of Hennebec and State of Maine,

in consideration of the sum of five hundred dollars
paid by Rowlanl Freeman of said Manchester, County and
State aforesaid.

the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge, do hereby give, grant, bargain, sell, and convey unto the said

Rowlanl Freeman his
heirs and assigns forever a certain tract of land situated in said Man-
chester and on the road from Manchester Centre to Headfield with
the buildings thereon. being the land deeded to me by John Day
and described in a deed from the said John Day to the recorder
in the Hennebec Registry of Deeds Book 38. page 413. containing
about thirty acres and sixty-seven rods.

Also a tract of land in said Manchester, being a part
of lot No. Thirty nine deeded to me by Isaac Luce and described in
a deed from said Luce to me recorded in the Hennebec Registry of
Deeds, Book 41. page 349. containing about ten acres.

Also a lot of land on the road from 3d Manchester to beddy,
a portion of lot No. thirty nine, deeded to me by Francis Day, described
in a deed from the said Francis Day to me recorded in the Hennebec Registry
of Deeds Book 154. page 292. containing twenty one and three quarters
acres more or less.

To have and to hold the aforesigned and bargained Premises, with all the privileges and appurtenances thereof,
to the said Rowlanl Freeman his
heirs and assigns, to their use and behoof forever. And I do covenant with the said Freeman,
heirs and assigns, that I am
lawfully seized in fee of the premises, that they are free of all incumbrances; that I have good right to sell and
convey the same to the said Freeman
to hold as aforesaid; and that I and my heirs shall and will WARRANT AND DEFEND the same to the said
Freeman and his
heirs and assigns forever, against the
lawful claims and demands of all persons.

and wife of the said
in testimony of her relinquishment of her right of dower in the above described premises, have hereunto set my

thousand eight hundred and seventy.
