The petition of John Fereday
of Logan City
Ter. of Utah respectfully shows:
That Sarah T Crawford died on or about the 26th
day of June 1883 at her res-
idence in Logan in said county

That said deceased at the time of his death was a resident of the
County of Cache in said Territory of Utah
and left estate in said county consisting of real and
personal property:

That the probable value and character of the said property are as follows, to wit:

1 3/8 square rods in Block 29 Plat-a Logan city survey
worth about \$600
2800 sq feet on Clock two plat-a Logan city survey
worth about \$920
Mortgage for \$200 due Feb 13th 1885 given
by William Fereday
Household Furniture worth about \$75⁰⁰

That the estate and effects, for or in respect of which the probate of the will hereinafter mentioned is hereinafter applied for, does not exceed the sum of Eighteen hundred fifty dollars:

That the next of kin of said testatrix whom your petitioner is advised and believes and therefore alleges to be the heirs at law of said testatrix, and the names and residence of said heirs are unknown to your petitioner but years, residing at he is advised that the nearest of kin of said deceased are two nieces residing in Monticello Minnesota

That at the time said will was executed, to wit: on the said twelfth
day of June 1883, the said testatrix was over the age of eighteen
years, to wit: of the age of 72 years or thereabouts,
and was of sound and disposing mind, and not acting under duress, menace, fraud,
or undue influence, and was in every respect competent, by last will, to dispose of
all his estate:

That said will is in writing signed by the said testatrix and attested by said
subscribing witnesses, at the request of said testatrix subscribing their names to the
said will in the presence of the said testatrix and in the presence of each other;
and that as your petitioner is advised, and therefore
alleges said witnesses, at the time of attesting the execution of said will, were, and
are now competent,

Wherefore your petitioner prays that the said will may be admitted to Probate,
and that Letters testamentary be issued to your petitioner and
that for that purpose you appoint a time for
proving said will, and that all persons interested be notified and directed to appear
at the time appointed for proving the same; and subpoenas be directed to be issued to
the said subscribing witnesses to the said will, residing in the said
County; and that all other necessary and proper orders may be made in the premises.

I Sarah T. Crawford of Logan City in
the County of Cache, Territory of Utah of the
age of seventy two years, and being of sound
and disposing mind and memory, and not
acting under duress, menace, fraud, or undue
influence of any person whatever, do make,
publish, and declare this my last Will and
Testament, in manner following, that is to say:

First I give, devise and bequeath to
John Fereday of Logan City in the County
of Cache and Territory of Utah all my
real estate and all my personal property
of every kind and description whatsoever
for his use and benefit and for the use
and benefit of his heirs and assigns forever.

Lastly: I hereby nominate and appoint
John Fereday of Logan City, Cache County,
Utah, the executor of this, my last Will and
Testament and hereby revoke all former wills
by me made.
