MRS. DAVID WHITE.

Mrs. David White passed away at the home of her daughter, Myrtle, in St. Paul on Saturday, December 4, following a lingering illness.

Elizabeth Ann Jones was born on January 3, 1864 in Castle Rock, the daughter of pioneer parents who came to Minnesota from Illinois in a covered wagon in 1838. When she was five the family moved to a farm west of Dundas which they homesteaded, and which is now occupied by Mr. and Mrs. Eng.

On November 9, 1881 she was united in marriage to David H. White, and they lived in Northfield for several years, then moved to St. Paul. In 1910, at the death of her parents, they came to Dundas and made their home here until failing health forced them to give up their own home. They went to St. Paul where they lived with their daughter and there Mr. White passed away in 1937.

Mrs. White was a life long member of the Methodist church.

She is survived by her two children, Everett and Myrtle, both of St. Paul, five grandchildren; eleven great grandchildren and a number of nieces and nephews.
