Dear Sir:

The following is a clinical summary in the case of the above named patient:

This 78 year old white male was transferred to Willmar State Hospital in 1943 from Fergus Falls State Hospital where he had been a patient since 1937. Hospital course was uneventful except for the fact that the patient was observed to be in auricular fibrillation in 1956. On 1-7-58 patient complained of extreme dysuria. On 1-9-58 he was admitted to the hospital ward because of melena. On examination he was found to be in acute congestive heart failure. Patient expired the same day.

Final diagnostic impression:

1. Congestive heart failure
2. Generalized arteriosclerosis
3. Schizophrenic reaction, paranoid type.
