Know all Men by these presents that I Nathaniel
 Tibbets of Boothbay in the County of Lincoln and Province
 of the Massachusetts Bay in New England, Yeoman, for &
 in consideration of one hundred pounds lawful Money
 of this Province aforesaid to me in hand before the En-
 sealing hereof well and truly paid by Andrew m^r Farland
 of Boothbay aforesaid, Gentleman, the Receipt whereof I
 do hereby acknowledge and myself therewith fully satisfied
 and contented, and thereof and of every part and parcel
 thereof do exonerate acquit and discharge the said Andrew
 m^r Farland his heirs Executors and Administrators for ever
 by these presents, have given, granted, bargained, sold, Alien
 conveyed & confirmed, and by these presents do freely, fully
 and absolutely give, grant, bargain, sell, alien, convey
 and confirm unto him the said Andrew m^r Farland, his
 heirs and assigns for ever, a certain Tract or parcel of land
 situate in Boothbay on the westerly side of the Back River
 so called, bounded as followeth, to wit, beginning at a pine
 Tree on the Bank of the said River, being the North East
 bounds of Mr. Thomas Kenney's Lot that he now dwells
 on, from said Tree running Northerly by said Shore to contain
 Eighty Rods front on said River and then to extend back
 both Southerly and Northerly Line of said Lot a West course
 to contain one hundred and thirty Acres more or less, bounded
 as aforesaid, being the Lot that the said Tibbets now dwells
 on - To have and to hold the said granted & bargained
 premises with all the Appurtenances privileges and
 Commodities to the same belonging or in any wise ap-
 pertaining to him the said Andrew m^r Farland his heirs &
 assigns for ever - to his and their only proper Use Benefit
 and behoof for ever - and I the said Nathaniel Tibbets
 for my self my heirs Executors and Administrators do
 covenant & grant to and with the said Andrew m^r Farland
 his heirs and assigns, that before the Ensealing hereof
 I am the true sole and lawful owner of the above

bargained premises and am lawfully seized & possessed
of the same in my own proper Right as a good perfect
and absolute Estate of Inheritance in fee simple &
have in myself good Right, full power and lawful
Authority to grant bargain & sell the same in manner
as aforesaid; and that the said Andrew Miffland his heirs
and assigns shall and may from Time to Time and at
all Times for ever hereafter by force and virtue of these
Presentes lawfully, peaceably and quietly have hold use
occupy possess and enjoy the said demised and bargained
premises with the Appurtenances free & clear and
freely and clearly acquitted exonerated and discharged
of and from all and all manner of other Gifts Grants
Bargains, Sales, Leases, Mortgages, Wills, Entails, Jointures
Dowries, Judgments Executions or Incumbrances of
what Name or Nature soever, that might in any Mea-
sure or Degree obstruct or make void this present Deed
Furthermore I the said Nathaniel Tibbets for my self
my heirs Executors and Administrators do covenant
and engage to warrant the above demised premises to
him the said Andrew Miffland his heirs and assigns
against the lawful claim or Demand of any Person
or Persons whatsoever for ever hereafter to warrant
secure and defend the same by these presents. —
